RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING ALL SPONSORSHIPS & EXHIBIT BOOTHS



All booths will be determined by level and assigned on a first come-first serve basis. Each application will be date-stamped at time received.

APPLICATION: All applications must be accompanied by payment in full for the sponsorship/exhibit booth. Applications must be received by the IPSCA no later than October 5, 2026. All cancellations must be received in writing. Any cancellations received before October 5, 2026 will be subject to a \$100.00 administrative fee. No refunds will be given for cancellations after October 5, 2026.

INSTALLATION OF EXHIBIT: Booths may be installed beginning at 6:00 am on Saturday, October 24, 2026. Displays must be ready for showing 30 minutes prior to the convention beginning at 8:00 am.

PROHIBITION: The IPSCA reserves the right to reject any display, materials or services offered by an exhibiting or sponsoring company if there is any conflict with the policies and principles of the IPSCA.

EXHIBIT HOURS:

Exhibits will be open from 8 am - 6:00 pm on Saturday, October 24, 2026. Ample time has been allotted with the convention schedule for viewing and visiting exhibitors. Exhibitors must occupy their booth during all hours of the seminar. All breaks will be arranged in the exhibit area. All materials must be removed from the area on Saturday, October 24, 2026 unless other arrangements have been made with the event site.

INSURANCE: The exhibitor and its agents of every kind agree to obtain insurance coverage for and during this event. It is further agreed that loss of, or damage to, person or property within the space allocated to the exhibitors, from fire, theft, pilferage, or otherwise shall be at the sole risk of the exhibitor.

CANCELLATION: The performance of this contract by either party is excused if made impossible or illegal by acts of God, war, government regulation, disaster, civil disorder, and curtailment

of transportation facilities, power outage, or other emergency over which any party has no control. This agreement may be terminated for one or more of such reasons by written notice from one party to the other, but upon termination of any such reason, exhibitor is not entitled to a refund or reimbursement. The exhibitor does not have the right to request a refund because the facility fails to provide any service (e.g., electricity goes out and attendees cannot see exhibit). Failure by the exhibitor to comply with these rules and regulations agreed by the parties or the breach of any representation, warranty, or guarantee by the exhibitor shall render the exhibitor liable for direct and consequential damages, expenses, allocations of overhead, etc., including but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees. This agreement represents the complete understanding of the parties and may be amended, or otherwise attend only pursuant to the mutual written agreement of the parties.

NON-LIABILITY: It is expressly understood and agreed by each and every contracting exhibitor and his or her guests that neither the IPSCA, nor its employees or its contractors shall be liable for loss or damage to the goods or properties of exhibitors. All property of the exhibitor is understood to remain under his/or her custody and control in transit to, within, or in transit from the confines of the exhibit hall, subject to the Rules and Regulations of this event. By completing the registration, exhibitor releases and agrees to indemnify the IPSCA, its managers, officers, members, sponsors, employees, and agents and indemnify and save them harmless from any suit or claim for property damage or personal injury (including punitive damages) by whomsoever sustained, including exhibitor and its employees, independent contractors, and agents of every kind or employees on or about the exhibitor's space or arising out of exhibitor's participation in the exhibition, expressly including such damage or injury resulting in any part from the

negligence of one or more of the aforementioned indemnities.

RESPONSIBILITY: Exhibitors shall be fully responsible to pay for any and all damages to the event site property, its employees, its owners or managers which result from any act or omission of exhibitor. Exhibitor agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless, the Illinois Prairie State Chiropractic Association and the event site, its owners, managers, officers, or directors, agents employees, subsidiaries and affiliates, from any damages or charges resulting from exhibitor's use of property. Exhibitor's liability shall include all losses, costs, damages, or expenses arising from, out of, or by reason of any accident or bodily injury or other occurrences, to any person or persons, including the exhibitor, its agents, employees, and business invitees which arise from or out of the exhibitor's occupancy and use of the exhibition premises, the event sites or any part thereof.

Failure of IPSCA to declare any violation of these rules immediately upon occurrence thereof, or delay in taking any action in connection therewith, shall not waive such violation. The receipt of any rent or payment by IPSCA with or without knowledge of any breach or violation by IPSCA of any conditions, terms or covenant, hereunder shall not be determined or considered as a waiver of any provision hereunder.
